

# Exploring Te Tiriti o Waitangi

## Why this activity

It allows us to reflect on generations that have gone before, and provides a space for tamariki to see themselves in this journey and the important role that they play.

## What I need

The worksheet printed for each ākonga.



## What to do

- Ask tamariki to think about themselves as 7 generations on from the signing of te Tiriti.
- Kōrero through the worksheet to begin.
- Start with the biggest whare, this is your tamariki today.

Ka mua, ka muri - walking backwards into the future.

## With younger tamariki:

- Be guided by our thinking.
- Perhaps you can reflect on this in a more collaborative way.
- They might write some words or draw pictures to depict this, but this is a big ongoing learning journey!

## Kōrero and reflect
